### Oliver Neubauer, violin

American violinist **Oliver Neubauer** is a YCA Jacobs Fellow as First Prize Winner of the 2023 YCA Susan Wadsworth International Auditions. Impacting audiences around the world with his uniquely beautiful playing and mature artistry, Oliver has been described as “grippingly precise and gleaming” by the San Francisco Classical Voice.

Oliver has appeared as soloist with numerous orchestras, including the National Repertory Orchestra, the Springfield Symphony, and the Symphony of Westchester. Other notable awards include Third Prize in the 2023 ArsClassica International Competition and the Gold Award at the 2018 National YoungArts Competition.

A passionate chamber musician, Oliver’s festival appearances have included Music@Menlo’s International Program, Verbier Festival Academy, Bravo! Vail, Lake Champlain Music Festival, Chamber Music Northwest, Music in the Vineyards, and Music from Angel Fire. He has collaborated with esteemed artists including Itzhak Perlman, Carter Brey, Ani Kavafian, Shai Wosner, Jason Vieaux, and the Dover Quartet.

Highlights of Oliver’s 24-25 season include appearances with the Delaware Symphony and Chamber Orchestra of the Triangle, as well as recital and chamber music performances at The Kennedy Center, Wigmore Hall, Merkin Hall, Buffalo Chamber Music Society, Friends of Chamber Music Kansas City, and Palm Beach Chamber Music Society, among others.

Oliver recently graduated from The Juilliard School where he was a proud recipient of the Kovner Fellowship and a student of Li Lin, Donald Weilerstein, and Itzhak Perlman.

Oliver plays on a 1780 J.B. Guadagnini violin, generously on loan to him from The Juilliard String Instrument Collection.
